Information Sheet

Description: An up-beat, high-energy dance class. This class introduces fundamentals and terminology of Jazz and Modern dance. It is intended to enhance a beginning student's flexibility, strength, body alignment, coordination, and balance through Jazz technique. Ballet is required due to the technical vocabulary of both jazz and modern. All students perform at the Clarke Theatre in June. Costumes are always provided for free at our Academy!



Dress Code (girls):

- Black Camisole leotard
- Black footed or footless tights or black socks
- Black shorts (optional)
- Black Jazz Shoes, slip-on, leather
- Pony Tail or Ballet Bun



Dress Code Notes:

- No hair accessories - optional black bun cover and hair band.

Dress Code (boys):

- Black Short-sleeved t-shirt
- Black Shorts or Tights
- Black Jazz Shoes, leather, slip-on

Class Information

- **Pre-Requisite:** Students must be in Primary or Grade 1 Ballet
- **Ages:** 7+ years
- **Class Duration:** 1 hour
- **Class Frequency:** 1 class per week
- **Session Duration:** September to June (new registrations accepted until December)

Payments & Policies

- **Tuition:** Visit the school website or contact the school office for current class fees.
- **Registration Fee:** Annual, non-refundable fee per student, due upon registration.
- **Payments:** Payments monthly in advance by automatic credit card processing (Visa, Mastercard), Bank Withdrawal or Post-dated cheques. Sibling discounts. Pre-payments must be in place prior to attending class, and to secure enrollment.
- **Cancellation:** Full refund if cancellation form received within 10 days of enrollment, excluding classes taken, otherwise a 30-day notice period is required. Cancellation forms are available on the school website.
